Exceptions to the policy is listed below.

VISITATION EXCEPTIONS (ALL MUST BE APPROVED BY CARE TEAM)

RED LEVEL GUIDANCE

Emergency Department	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• One parent or one guardian of pediatric patients for the duration of stay• One visitor, must be same person, for patients with intellectual, developmental, or other cognitive disability for the duration of stay
Surgery/Procedure Patients	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Provided social distancing can be accomplished, one visitor until patient is taken into prep.<ul style="list-style-type: none">o Visitor must then leaveo Visitor may not be present during procedures or in the recovery room; except for patients with intellectual, developmental, or other cognitive disability.
Adult In-Patient Psychiatry	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Permission to visit must be approved by care team in advance of visit, including time and duration of visit
End of Life	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Up to two visitors at a time

All visitors, if approved, must:

- o must be age 18 years or older.
- o be screened upon entry for symptoms of illness
- o maintain social distancing guidelines and wear a face mask at all times.
